

Making your loudspeaker data available to the EASE community

1. Data Creation

There are several ways to generate loudspeaker data for EASE. The simplest way is to create a text file in a defined format and import it into EASE, just as described in the document http://www.auralisation.de/dir_dnl/speakerformats404.zip under www.auralisation.de. Here, it is also described how impulse response and frequency response data (such as from EASERA, TEF or MLSSA) can be used directly to generate EASE balloon data.

On the other hand, if you do not have measurement data available you may want to turn to one of the independent labs offering loudspeaker measuring services. Among them are:
